



Huon Highway Shoulder Sealing Fleurty's Road to Shipwright Point

The Tasmanian Government is committed to improving safety on the Huon Highway. Shoulder sealing will be undertaken along a 5.5 kilometre section of the highway south of Franklin from the Fleurty's Road junction to Shipwrights Point in Port Huon.

Road works will commence in January 2018 and be completed by the end of April 2018, subject to weather conditions.

The work will also include sealing the gravel informal pull-over area opposite Huon Eldercare in Franklin. This will be sealed and signed to provide a viewing / photo opportunity area for tourists to safely stop off the highway.

The project is a component of the *Huon Highway Corridor Study 2012* which provides a prioritised list of road improvement projects to improve safety and provide a more consistent travel environment from Huonville to Southport. These works are a continuation of the shoulder sealing and road safety improvements which have been undertaken on the Huon Highway between Huonville and Geeveston over the past five years.

The road works will be performed under an approved traffic management plan by the contractor to ensure the least possible disruption to road users. Speed restrictions and altered traffic conditions will be in place throughout the construction period to ensure a safe work place for construction staff and the travelling public.

Delays can be expected in the vicinity of the construction works for the duration of the project. Please obey all signs and allow for sufficient time for travelling through the work area.
